

## ***Jeffrey L. Pierce Memorial Scholarship***

Ms. Mary V. Bordier created a Trust to provide scholarships to Jefferson County students. The scholarship is named in honor of her son, Jeffrey L. Pierce, a 1974 graduate of Jefferson High School.

Ms. Bordier believed in the education of our youth. She provided the scholarship to assist students with financial need to obtain a college education.

Mary V. Bordier died November 10, 2011 but her memory, along with her son's will continue to live on through the Jeffrey L. Pierce Memorial Scholarship.

Scholarship Title:           **Jeffrey L. Pierce Memorial Scholarship**

Criteria:

1. **One scholarship offered at either Jefferson or Washington High School.**
2. GPA minimum of 2.75.
3. Accepted as full time student to post-secondary program located in West Virginia.
4. Financial need is a consideration.

Amount:                   \$1,000.00 payable to student and post-secondary institution.

Deadline:                April 11

Application Process:    The applicant must submit:

1. Scholarship Application Form
2. Letter explaining why scholarship is requested and what area of interest applicant will be pursuing in post-secondary school. Include name, address and telephone number in letter.
3. Copy of transcript, attendance and discipline report showing good citizenship.
4. Include copy of letter of acceptance to post-secondary institution.
5. List of extracurricular activities in school and/or community.
6. Include one letter of recommendation.
7. Include scholarship application financial need statement to show proof of financial need.

Selection Process:      Final selection of award recipient is made by the Bordier Family.

**Submit all information to your Guidance Office by April 11<sup>th</sup>.**

Scholarship will be awarded at the Senior Awards night in May.

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The selection of award recipient is based solely on the eligibility criteria as defined in the scholarship trust, and is made without regard to race, religion, national origin, ancestry, sex, age, or disability.

1. *This application, your grade transcripts, and all required documentation must be submitted and received by **APRIL 11th** during your Senior year at Jefferson or Washington High School.*

**Submit all information to your Guidance Office by April 11<sup>th</sup>**

*Applications submitted without required documentation or without your signature will be deemed incomplete and will not be considered.*

➤ **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. *Graduating Seniors from Jefferson or Washington High School, Jefferson County, WV.*
2. *The student must be accepted to a post-secondary accredited school (i.e. University; College; Junior College; or Vocational school) located in West Virginia, with a defined course of study.*
3. *Student must have an over-all 2.75 grade point average.*
4. *This application must be submitted by the student, and should discuss the student's citizenship, school and community activities, career plans, interests, and other information that may identify the student as a worthy recipient of the scholarship. In addition, the application must include a copy of the student's cumulative grade reports; school attendance and discipline records; and documentation of acceptance by a post-secondary school located in West Virginia.*

*Scholarship will be awarded at the Senior Awards night in May. Scholarship award for \$1,000 will be payable to student and post-secondary institution.*

**DEADLINE:            APRIL 11th**

**APPLICATION PROCESS:            Submit all information to your Guidance Office by April 11<sup>th</sup>.**





➤ **Statement of Applicant:**

*In making this application, I understand that eligibility is contingent upon:*

- *Graduation from Jefferson or Washington High School with a minimum 2.75 grade point average.*
- *A record of good community service/citizenship.*
- *Full-time enrollment status at Jefferson or Washington High School.*

*Further, I understand that the criteria for the selection of Scholarship Recipients is not based exclusively on academic records, and that the selection criteria includes citizenship and other subjective factors.*

*I understand that the award value of the scholarship is \$1,000.*

*I certify that the **information presented** in the application is **true and correct** and understand that the **Trustee** reserves the right to **terminate** any scholarship award to an applicant who submits **false or inaccurate information** in the application.*
